# SATURDAY MINI SHOW \* 1:00-2:00pm

This show is for the youngest classes: Creative Movement, Contemporary, Pre-Ballet, Pre-Tap, Ballet 1, Tap 1, Boys 1, all Adult Tap, PLUS Francis Performing Arts Companies. You will need separate tickets for this "Mini" show; there is a 10-ticket limit for this show at Presales. Dancers in the Mini will NOT need tickets; only audience members. Mini Show dancers will stay back stage for this 45 minute show. Older APA dancers and adult volunteers will help with costume changes so parents can enjoy the show! If you purchase tickets for the 3:00 performance as well, please clear the auditorium, and re-enter at 2:30 for the Main Show. If you are taking your "Mini" show dancer to watch "Main" show, please remember NO COSTUMES ALLOWED IN THE AUDIENCE.

#### **RECITAL TICKETS**

"Mini Show" tickets \$8.00; lap-sitters free.

"Main Show" tickets \$12.00 all seats.

Prices remain same at all sales, including at the door. Do NOT call the Alma College box office OR HIS Place regarding tickets! If you have questions, contact Kathy at APA.

Ticket sellers are volunteers and are not responsible for making special decisions. Know how many tickets you need for which show; consider what area of auditorium you would like but don't expect to hand select exact seats. Sellers will help you get "best possible"; all seats have excellent views. All Presales are for dancers' immediate families only please. Tickets available at doors.

ALL PRE-RECITAL TICKET PURCHASES are limited to 10 tickets per family total for "Main" shows. Additional tickets may be purchased at the LAST rehearsal sale date, and at the door of each performance. This is 10 tickets TOTAL per family, not per show, so that additional tickets are still available rehearsal week and at the door June 8 & 9. There is also a 10-ticket limit for the 1:00 "Mini" Show per family; this is separate from the "Main" Show limit. We will not sell out. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated! This is to ensure that all families see their children dance!

NOTE: Families who have dancers in both Mini Show and Main Show or have 3 or more dancers needing more than 10 tickets for <u>immediate</u> family: Please make any special arrangements to purchase any extra tickets <u>with Kathy</u>, <u>prior to May 15</u> sale.

# **COSTUME HAND OUT & FITTING**

Costumes will be handed out the week of April 29-May 2 at the beginning of each class. All students must wear basic leotard and tights so costumes can be pulled on in the dance studio! They will not be allowed to take costume parts to the bathroom to try on! Chris Santana (seamstress) will be on-site to make quick alterations, or to mark so parents/students can make adjustments. Chris can take more complicated alterations to fix and have returned for Photos May 10 and 11. Very basic and reasonable costs: sew straps \$2; hem/shorten \$5; take in at sides \$3; other, more complicated alterations to be determined. Please pay cash or check to Chris Santana.

Costumes will not be released if any account balances are due. Final billing and credit statements are attached.

Bring Credit Statements to Recital Ticket Sale and they can be used for tickets or may be used for fall Enrollment Fee. All costumes are shown in the Costume Book at the studio. Make sure your child has proper colored shoes and tights as shown in these books.

Use back studio entry only – front entry will be blocked to make easier traffic pattern. Kathy and other instructors will attend all photo shoots to help with posing but think about pose ideas in advance! There is no obligation to purchase, but APA would like ALL your smiling faces on my wall in the studio composite!

- Pay Ash Lin Portraits at time of shoot. Order forms will be available at our studio to help you make decisions in advance.

- Sign up for day and time on clipboard at studio.
- If you are doing multiple costumes, sign up in a separate 15-minute time slot for each costume. Multiple kids within a family can be signed up in same time slot if there's no costume change involved.
- Wear proper tights and shoes, fix hair, and wear less (if any) make-up than for performance.
- Ash Lin will have digital photos ready for you to pick up at designated times at dress rehearsals! Watch for times!

#### PARENT HELPERS – APA Minion Squad

"APA Minion Squad" parents would like to help everyone understand and enjoy recital more! Experienced parents know there are always questions, especially from new students and their parents, as well as from returning families! Parent assistance and volunteers are so important for a smooth running recital, and we would like to encourage you to find the best way to help to use your talents, time and ability to have more involvement with your kids! "APA Minion Squad" will be on hand at Ticket Sales and Photo Days to answer questions and get volunteers into a perfect place! We can't do it without parent volunteers! Thank you!

Various types of involvement suggested:

Set up dressing room area in college dance studio before rehearsals begin.

Help in dressing room during rehearsals or shows – Parents of boys, please help with boys.

(Older APA dancers will help in dressing room during the Mini Show so parents of youngest dancers can enjoy the show.) Make-up

Usher during shows. Help seat, hand out programs, watch for camera lights! NO cameras or phone recording during shows! Un-tape and roll up dance floor when show is over on Sunday – Clean and pick up after show Sunday.

We will again have a live feed from the stage to the Dance Studio so dancers and helpers can watch the show from the big dressing room! This will take some extra set up of the dance studio dressing room. 3:00 Shows are identical – you may attend one, and assist with the other, and see all of your student's dances!

<sup>\*</sup> Attendance the remainder of the year is very important!

#### **HELPFUL HINTS**

Write out the order of your dances if you have more than one dance to plan your costume changes. Include color of tights and accessories you need. Wear a base of nude tights, or sheer nylons, or body tights or unitard, and other tights will slide on and off over them as needed. It is difficult changing tights on sweaty legs! Body tights or "body unders" are also good for changing costumes "modestly" in the large dressing room. These may be purchased at one of the posted dance stores or online at Discount Dance.

#### **COSTUMES**

- Once costumes are sent home, do your alterations if Chris Santana or someone else is not doing them for you. *Many costumes require minor alterations and finishing such as straps, flowers, and lacing.* Ready-made costumes do not fit every body type perfectly out of the bag!
- Be careful not to lose accessories, hair pieces, belts they are impossible to replace. DO NOT PLAY IN OR WEAR COSTUMES PRIOR TO REHEARSALS! Keep them nice for pictures, rehearsals, and shows.
- DO NOT USE PINS! <u>Sew</u> accessories according to picture in book. Most straps go straight across shoulder, do not tie around neck or cross in back except as instructed. Hem or cut pants. NO PINS! Pins tear fabric & fall out; pins falling out on stage are dangerous.
- STEAM wrinkles out (in hot steamy bathroom), or LIGHT COOL IRON WRONG SIDE CAREFULLY. Hang to keep neat.
- Hang tutu skirts UPSIDE DOWN from crotch fabric, to keep fluffed out, and up.

#### PRACTICE MUSIC FOR STUDENTS

If you have email mp3 capabilities, we can email you music. Name of song and artist will be listed at studio doors each day on the class schedule of the day. Many songs are easy to find on Itunes, but some songs have been edited, and will be noted on the schedule sign. Best suggestion: Record your student's class with your Iphone or Ipad so you not only have music, but the dance itself for them to look at and practice with! (Ask teacher to play full music if they are not yet finished.)

Practice makes a better recital experience! (Perfect) Practice makes perfect!

#### **RECITAL DVD's**

A SURVEY MONKEY link was sent via email. Please reply to help with some final decisions re: this year's Recital DVD's. Recital DVD's are produced by *Kreider Media* in Mt. Pleasant. We will take orders at performances, and order forms will be available in advance. We choose the best of each dance from the Sat/Sun "Main" shows. Last year's prices are still in place at this time; Main Show is a 2 DVD set @ \$40; \$50 blue ray. Mini Show single disc @ \$25; \$30 blue ray. Last year's pricing includes shipping.

There will be NO RECORDING ALLOWED AT REHEARSALS as in the past, and as always, no recording or photos allowed during performances.

#### **FLOWER and T-SHIRT SALES**

Francis Performing Arts Company again will sell LIVE ROSES at each performance, and "25th Anniversary 2019" recital T-shirt orders will be taken! These are fund-raisers for our performance groups. Your support is greatly appreciated!

#### **STAGE MAKE-UP**

Moms, do younger children yourself - we will check them. Stage makeup is similar to street make-up, just a little more pronounced. BLEND! You need to be seen from the balcony, and the amount of light directed on you is extremely bright and will wash out your features. Do not share make-up (especially mascara and liner) without clean, or disposable brushes/q-tips. You should invest in your own; sharing make-up also shares bacteria. Older students should practice and learn how to apply your own make-up. Younger students, try to learn, too! I will have people to HELP & CHECK your make-up, but don't rely on them - there isn't time for them to do everyone! Do makeup at home, then bring it with you for touch ups.

Here are some hints and items you should have:

- 1 Water based make-up, preferably a shade darker than your natural skin tone.
- 2 Blush, in a color which compliments your coloring.
- 3 Powder shadows in natural colors (bronze, etc) no blues or greens. Maybelline and others offer great "kits".
- 4 Eyebrow pencil, eyeliner, mascara brown (fair haired) or black (dark haired).
- 5 Moist lipstick clear red shades (bronze for boys)
- 6 Brushes, q-tips and/or throw away sponges for applying make-up, & a box of soft tissues and/or baby wipes.
- 8 Bring plenty of supplies for your hair; bobby pins, coated rubber bands, clips, spray. Scrunchies don't hold!
- 9 No glitter make-up unless directed for the entire class for a specific dance and costume look.

#### HAIR

All hair should be up, beautifully pulled away from face. This is a wonderful opportunity to have dancers' hair done for this special occasion! Short hair can be done nicely by braiding hair away from the face. Preference is to have all hair UP, off the neck. But short styles need to be cleanly pulled back from the eyes, especially. Help your dancer so their hair is NOT a distraction during their special time on stage!

#### \* NOTE CHANGES \* RULES FOR USE OF ALMA COLLEGE HERITAGE CENTER

It is because of your help and responsibility that we continue to be able to use the Heritage Center at Alma College! I am proud that our studio has a history of respectful use of this wonderful theater! *Thank you!* 

- ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD OR DRINKS in Heritage Center building AT ANY TIME! (except water)
- ABSOLUTELY NO CHEWING GUM in Heritage Center building! We paid damages one year; NO GUM!
- Always enter through rear entrance (north side) of building during rehearsals. Dancers are not to be in lobby.
- Always WALK in the halls and in the auditorium. No running.
- No tap dancing on the Heritage Center tile floors! Tap on stage or in Dance Studio only.
- No wandering around Heritage Center building. You should be either in dressing room or auditorium at all times.
- Parents are welcome to stay and watch rehearsals, but please take responsibility for ANY student, not just your own, in following rules regarding food, drink, quiet, respectful behavior, and cleaning up.
- Leave all costumes and dance bags in dressing rooms. NO LOOSE COSTUMES OR BAGS IN AUDITORIUM. Put on your first costume and go to Auditorium. Sit with others in your dance class.
- Watch rehearsals politely and quietly. This is your opportunity to see dances! Students will be directed backstage 1-2 dances prior to their dance. Recital order will be posted in Auditorium and in Dressing Rooms.
- Costumes may be left, neatly hung and organized in dressing rooms from Monday through Sunday.
  - Have names inside costumes & shoes! Each year costumes are taken by mistake; find a way to identify yours!
- No student should leave building until his/her belongings are neatly organized and any trash is disposed of properly.
- NO VIDEO RECORDING (phone or other) during REHEARSALS OR PERFORMANCES.
- Parents may take STILL PHOTOS, no flash, during REHEARSALS ONLY.
- NO RECORDING OF ANY KIND DURING PERFORMANCES.

NEVER TOUCH ANY STAGE ITEMS - curtains, lights, props, equipment, or anything else on the stage area. Expensive camera equipment was damaged last year by children allowed on stage after a performance. PLEASE SHARE THIS INFO with all family members attending performances. NO ONE ON STAGE, or touching anything on stage before, during, or after any rehearsals or performances! *This was costly and avoidable!* 

### **OTHER PHOTO & RECORDING INFO**

#### ALMA COLLEGE DOES NOT ALLOW RECORDING IN THE AUDITORIUM.

Still photos may be taken at REHEARSALS ONLY with NO FLASH. Flash photography is extremely dangerous to performers on stage, and especially to young children unaccustomed to being on stage. Make sure you use a camera that can be set for NO FLASH, or you will be asked to refrain from shooting. Be assured, that using a flash from the audience will not enhance your photo! The bright lights from the stage are all you need!

#### ABSOLUTELY NO RECORDING (video or still) during PERFORMANCES.

It is dangerous for dancers; it is totally distracting and rude to other audience members; it is not allowed in ANY theater. Cell phone signals also affect the sound system and headsets in the theater. Tech crews on the headsets know immediately that a cell phone is in use, even just a text! Please be considerate of all audience members and our show and use no cameras or phones during performances!

Note: You cannot post photos of other people's children on Facebook or any other social media site without their permission. Your APA fall contract serves as a photo release for your child only for photos and video taken for, or by APA only, not private individuals.

ANY PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHERS (anyone taking photos to sell in any way) MUST GET PERMISSION FROM APA PRIOR TO REHEARSAL WEEK to take any photography during rehearsals.

Notify APA to receive a Photography Permission Form. Photos can only be taken of specific clients/dancers/seniors and not of any other dancers that you have not been hired to shoot. Photos of dancers absolutely are not to be posted on Facebook or web sites without written permission from APA and parents of involved children.

### **DRESSING ROOM ASSIGNMENTS** - for all rehearsals and performances

Women's Locker Room FPACo 1 dancers + Ballet 6, Jazz 6, Modern 6

Please, <u>no exceptions</u> to the designated students in dressing rooms! It's important to avoid the hurt feelings "exceptions" will cause. There are simply NO other spaces available at the college for use as dressing rooms! We are VERY FORTUNATE to be able to use the Dance Studio as a dressing room!

NOTE: In the Dance Studio Dressing Room, dads & boys need to stay at the NORTH END of the Dance Studio away from the dressing area dividers if you need to come to the dressing room. We have <u>some</u> privacy dressing screens owned by the studio. All students are encouraged to bring in other privacy screens and portable clothing racks to set up dressing areas in the dance studio.

These screened areas are to be used for CHANGING COSTUMES ONLY, and NOT to be used as costume storage areas, play areas, or "forts" and personal "hang-outs". Respect each other's privacy & belonging. Costumes should be hung on ballet barres or clothing racks, NOT kept in changing areas.

Keep some areas open for warm-up, practice and video or "play" areas! We may leave our belongings in the room during this week, but the dance studio must be cleaned up after every rehearsal, & all belongings moved to costume hanging areas of the room.

#### NO PHOTOS taken in the Dance Studio Dressing Room. Move to the hallway to keep the dressing room a safe zone.

NO STREET SHOES in the dance studio. Helpers bring slippers or clean shoes! Be careful of the special dance floor.

NO FOOD or GUM inside the Heritage Center! WATER bottles only! Use the Tech Week rehearsal schedule to plan meal breaks for your dancer(s). All dancers will need to LEAVE THE BUILDING for meals. If weather is good, they may COVER or CHANGE FROM COSTUMES and eat outside but CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF! The Kitchen near north-east entrance is the only place you can eat inside. Clean up your mess!

Rehearsal Week – ALL IN COSTUME, ALL ON STAGE. Each Act will have a first rehearsal to work on spacing & lights for each dance (approx. 10-15 minutes per dance), and 1 Final Dress Rehearsal (no stops). WEAR COSTUMES FOR EVERY STAGE REHEARSAL for us to set lights, and check costumes, and for dancers to get used to dancing in costumes.

- Parents and professional photographers are taking pictures and videos be in costume for them!
- Dress rehearsals are the only opportunity for most students to see other dances on the stage. Watch your friends dance!
- Be supportive and encouraging to younger students! Check out what the other students are doing!
- Use designated dressing rooms, and go straight to the auditorium, ready to dance.

BE READY TO DANCE 15 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR TIME SLOT IN CASE WE ARE ABLE TO MOVE AHEAD!

We are often able to move ahead! We can NOT wait for dancers! We do well each year staying on schedule, but we need everyone's cooperation to do so. We will never move ahead more than 15 minutes.

Class time from the school year is shown (parenthesis) to help you confirm your child's dance.
